Homework:

Homework both learning and written will be set by teachers to reinforce the teaching and material studied in class. It is also used to extend the learners insight in the subject matter and also as a method of revision. Homework will be required on the day and date indicated by the teacher. Homework must be recorded by students in their student diary (homework section) and Parents or Guardians must sign the diary at the end of each week.

Failure on the part of a student to record or complete homework assignments will be dealt with in the first instance by the teacher. Continued failure on the part of a student to record or complete homework assignments will be notified to the year head who will contact the parent/guardian.

Sanctions such as detention may be imposed by the teacher/ Year Heads in order to achieve the completion of the exercises.
