School Policy on Uniform:

The wearing of our full and correct school uniform and compliance with the schools dress code is required of each learner attending our school. The wearing of uniform is also required during State Examinations (Junior and Leaving Certificate) and for all school-based activity including games etc. which may be located outside of the school grounds. This rule does not apply to those attending our PLC day courses.

The uniform consists of the following:

Male: Navy Jumper (Vee Neck-school crest embossed)

White Shirt (with collar) Junior Cycle students only

Pale Blue Shirt (with collar) Senior Cycle students only

Navy Blue Trousers

Black Shoes

Official School Jacket (optional)

Female: Navy Jumper (Vee Neck- school crest embossed)

White Shirt (with collar) Junior Cycle students only

Pale Blue Shirt (with collar) Senior Cycle students only

Navy Blue Trousers or knee length navy blue skirt

Black Shoes

Official School jacket (optional)

The wearing of a wristwatch and a medical band is permitted for both Male and Female learners. Females are allowed one pair of discrete earrings. Body piercing e.g. nose, eyebrow etc, and large hoop earrings are not permitted as they may cause injury to the learner.

No other form of dress is acceptable in school and the wearing of runners is prohibited only where the student is involved in PE or Games.

All students must enter and leave the school each day in the correct and complete uniform.

Your cooperation is requested in ensuring that all students present themselves to school in a neat, clean and tidy manner, and that they wear the full and correct school uniform as stated above. This rule is rigorously enforced.

A student may be sent home if they are not wearing the correct and complete uniform.
